

PUBLICATIONS BY AND ABOUT THOMAS MERTON

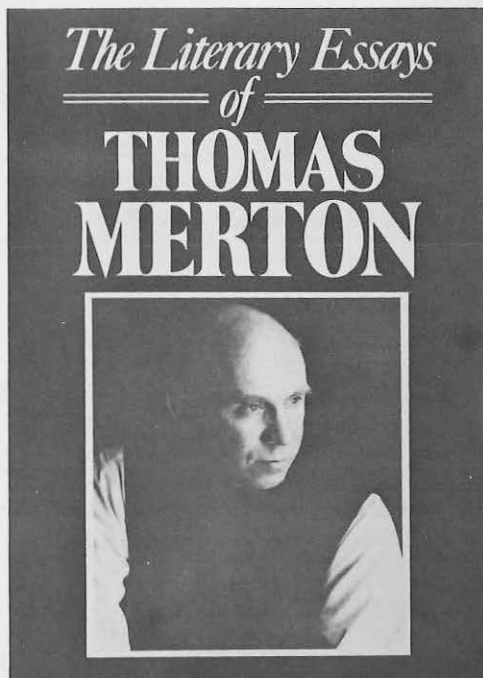
